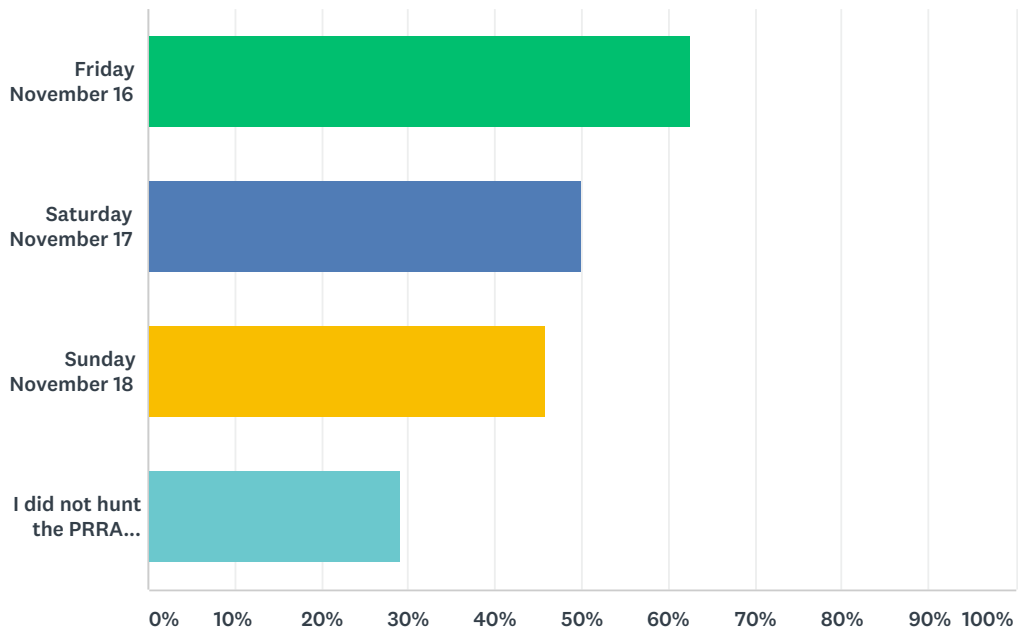

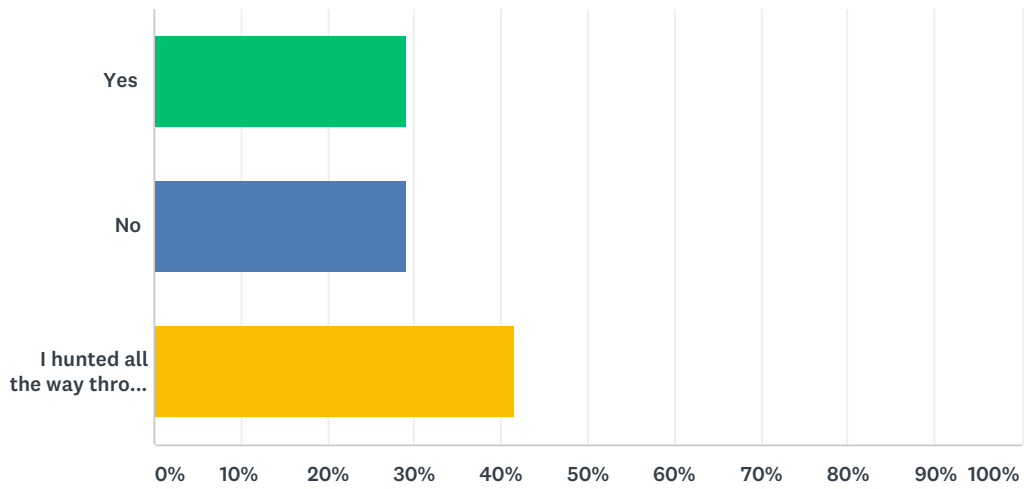

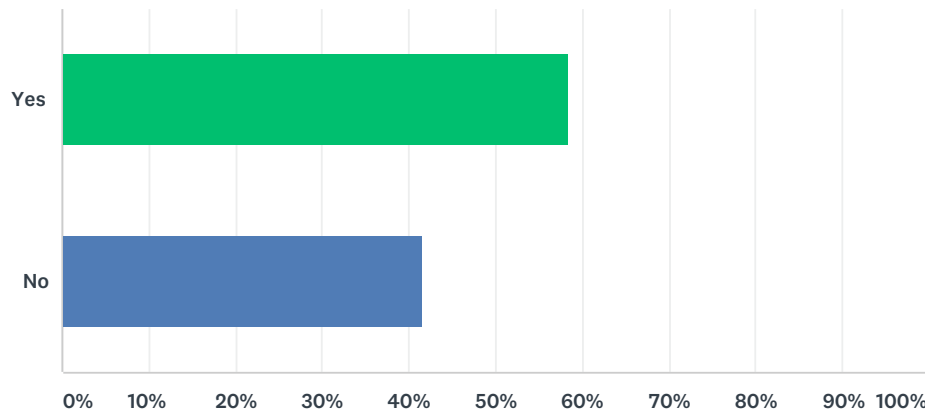

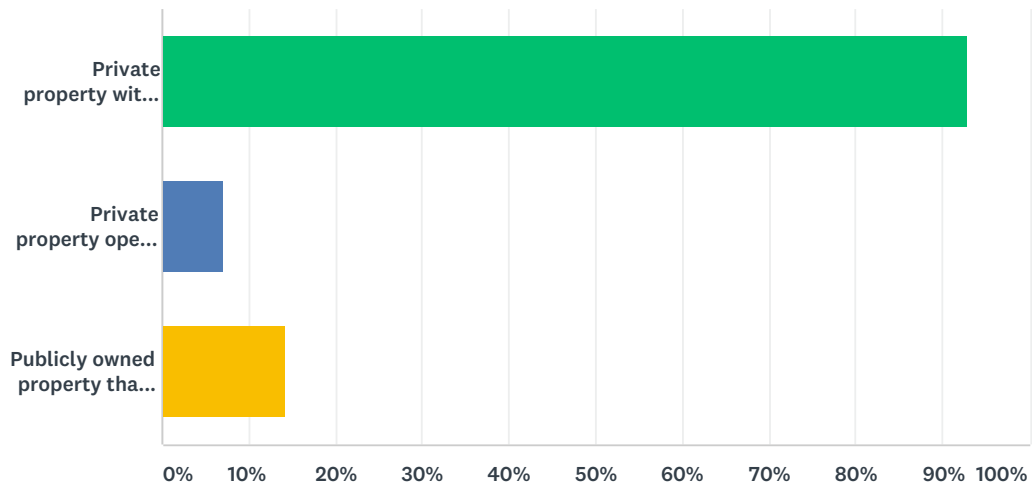

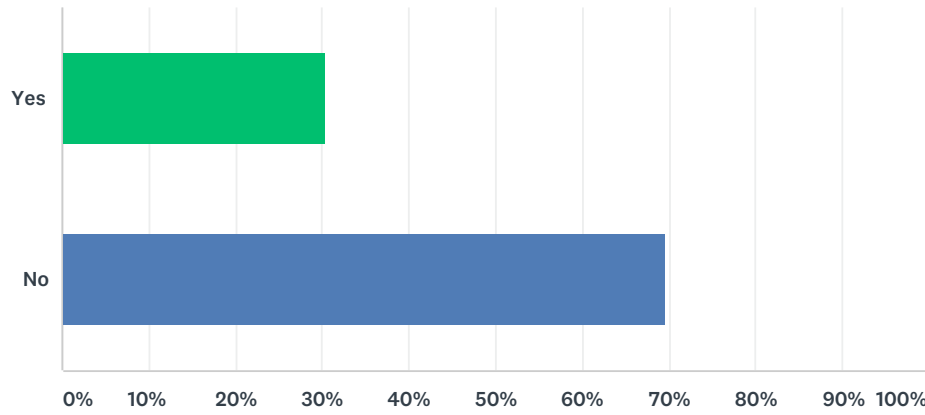

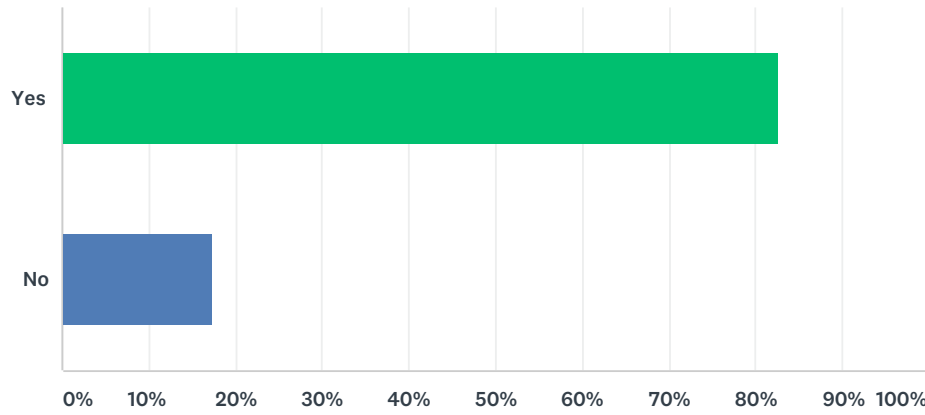

Q10 Should rifle deer hunting be allowed on the PRRA areas?

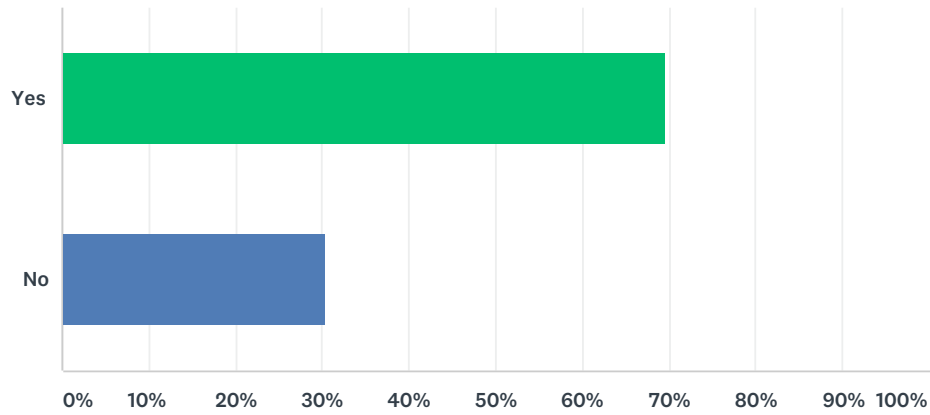

Q11 Would you continue to deer hunt on the PRRA areas if the use of high power rifles was eliminated during the rifle firearm season on these areas?

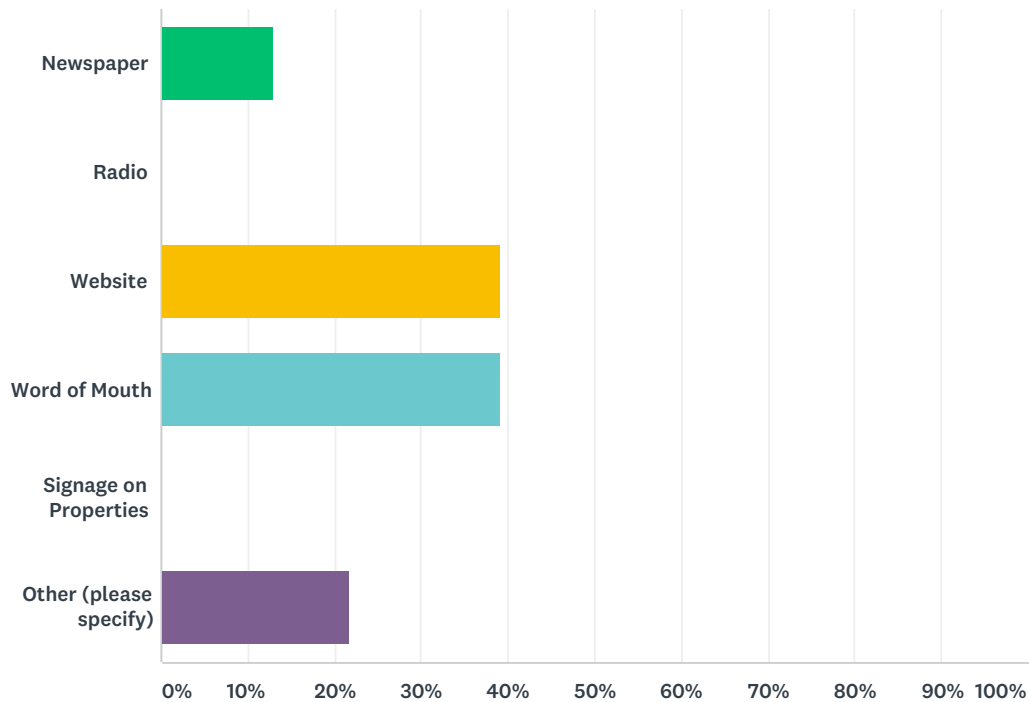

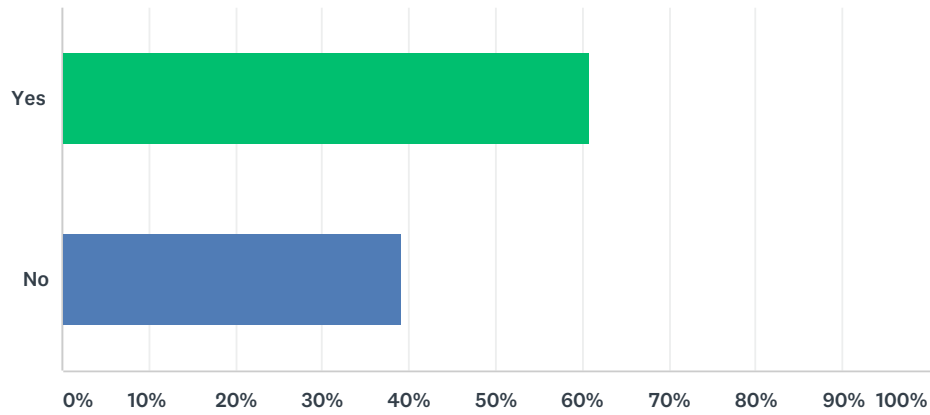

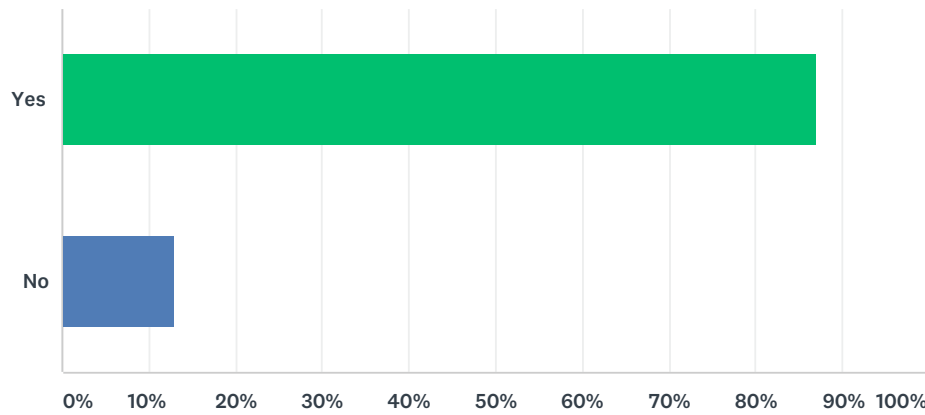

Q14 At this time are you aware of PRRIP's mission and work along the Platte River?

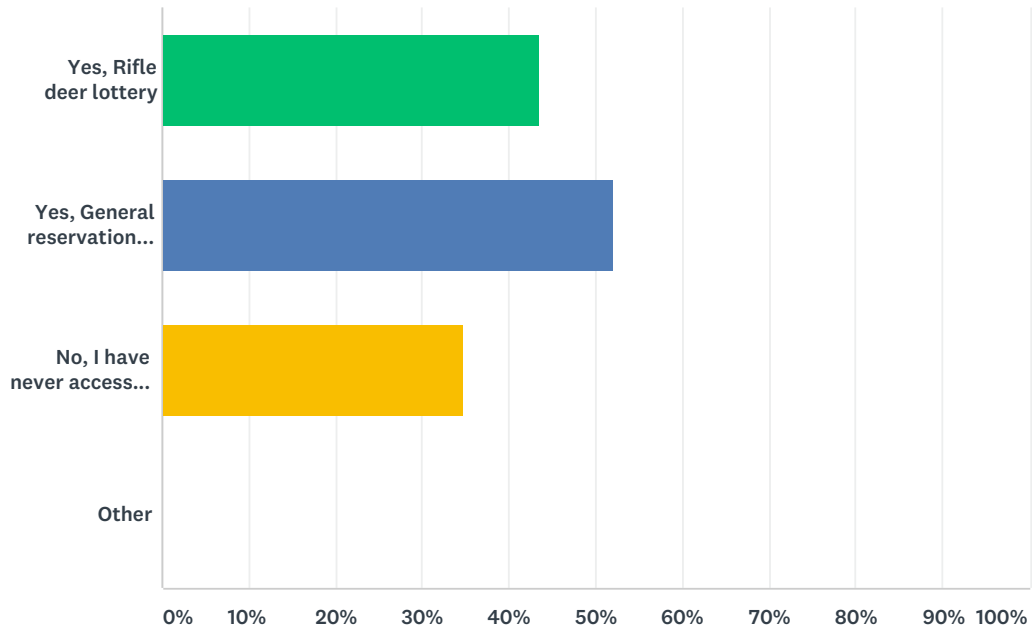

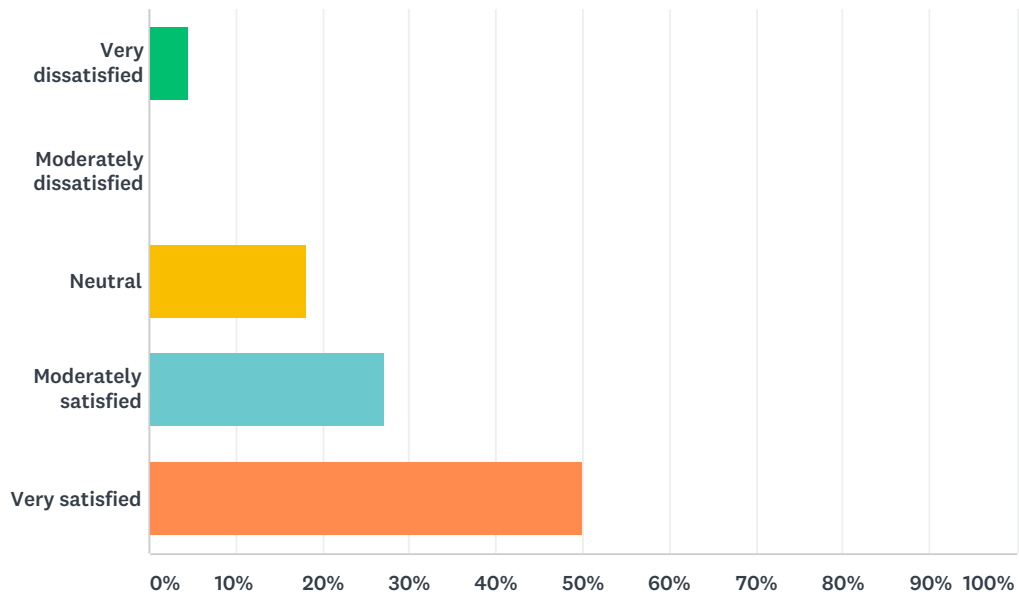

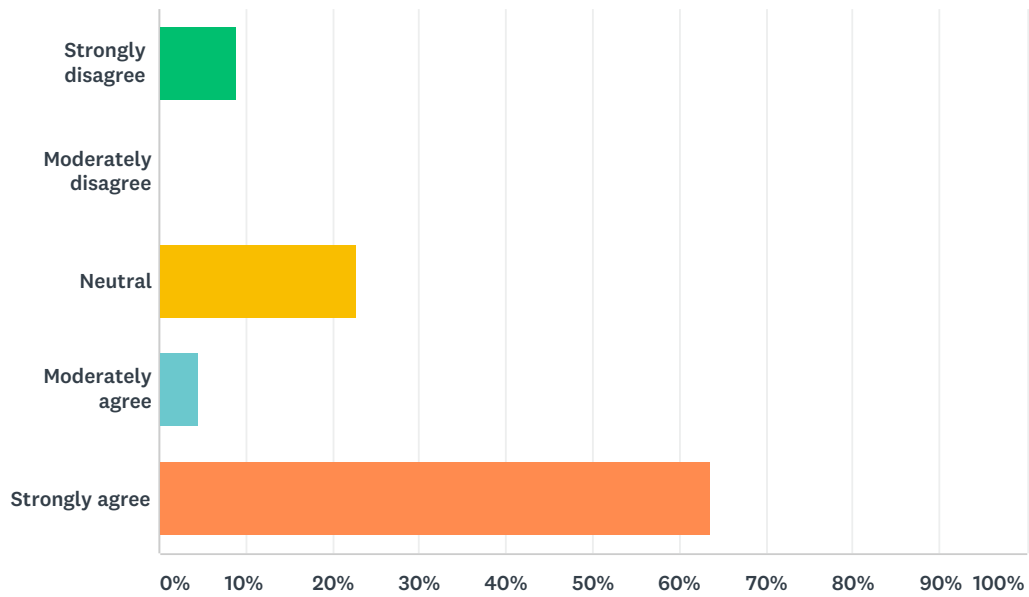

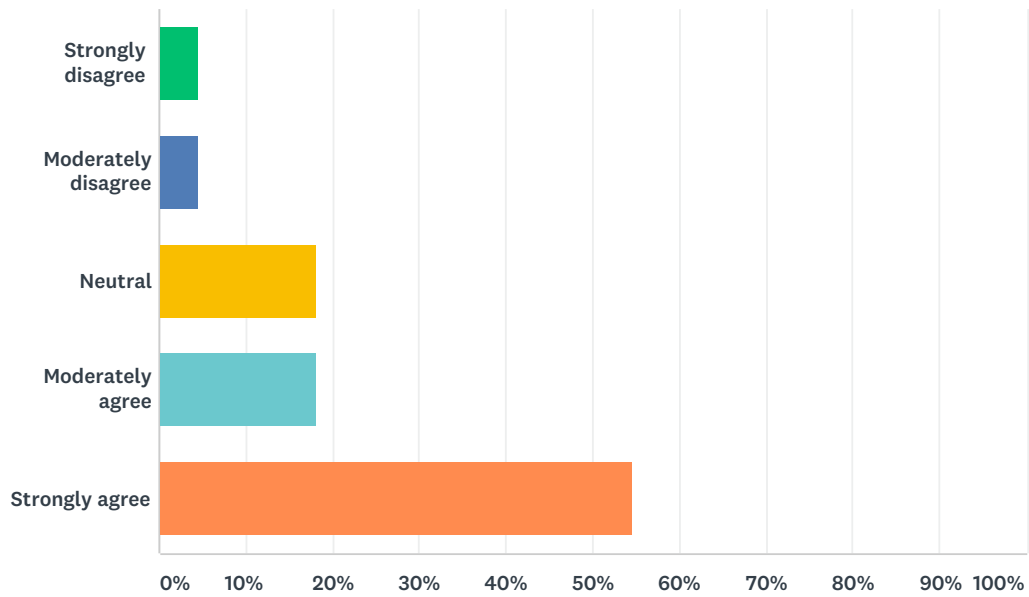

Q20 Do you agree with the following statement: I would recommend PRRA sites to a friend or relative to hunt?

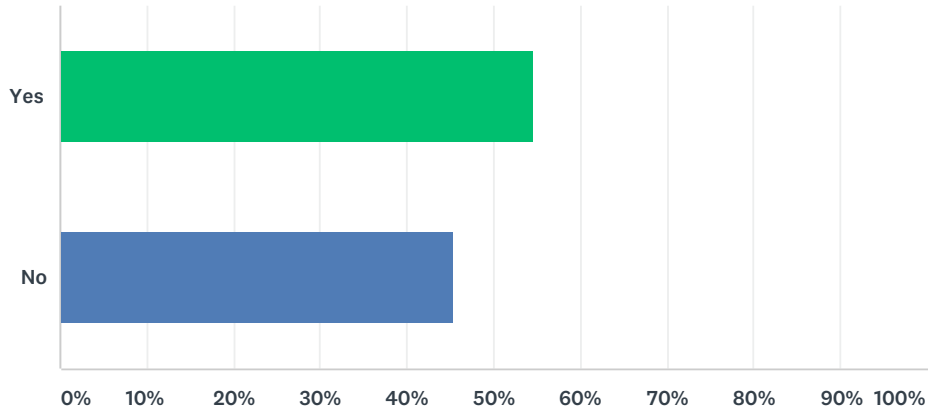

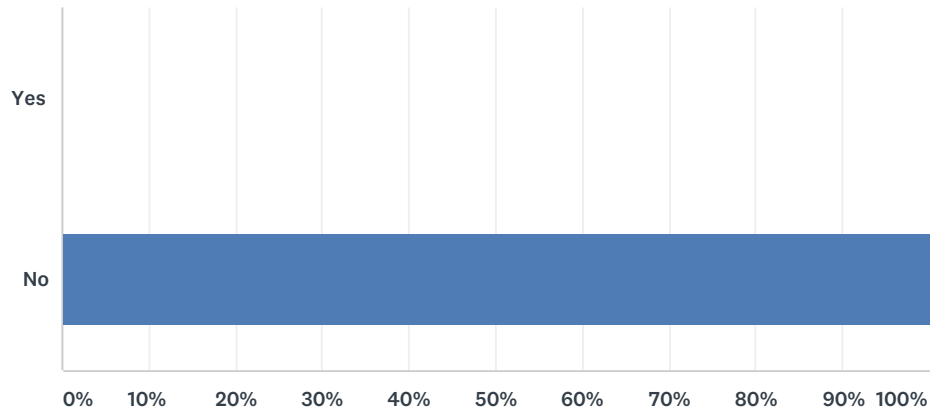

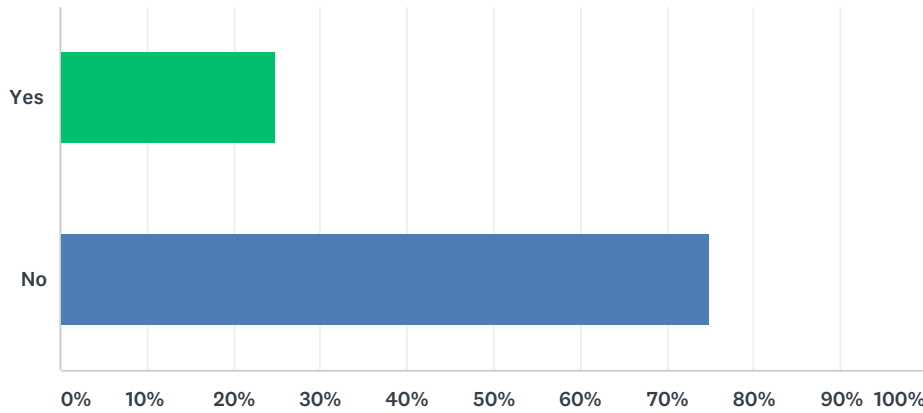

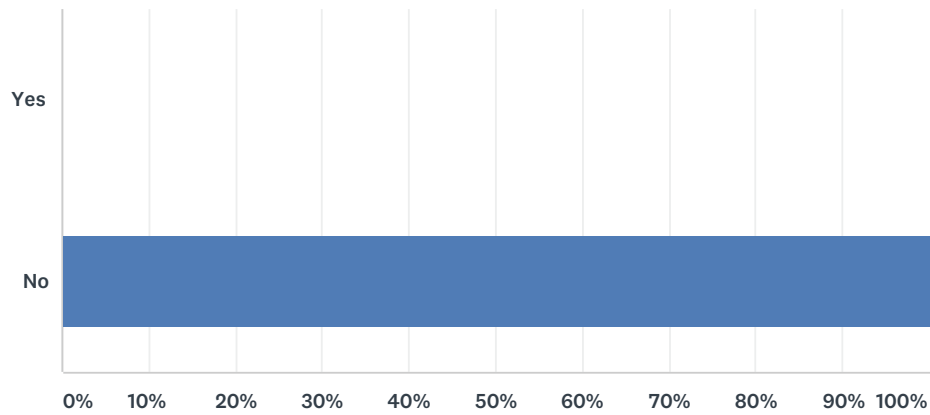
