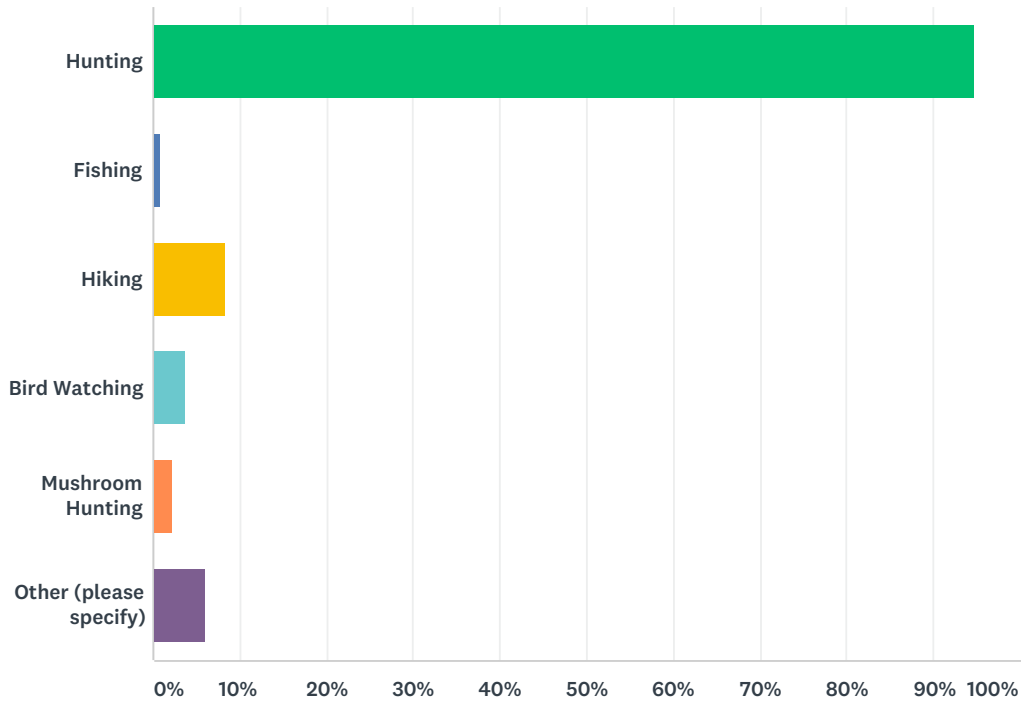

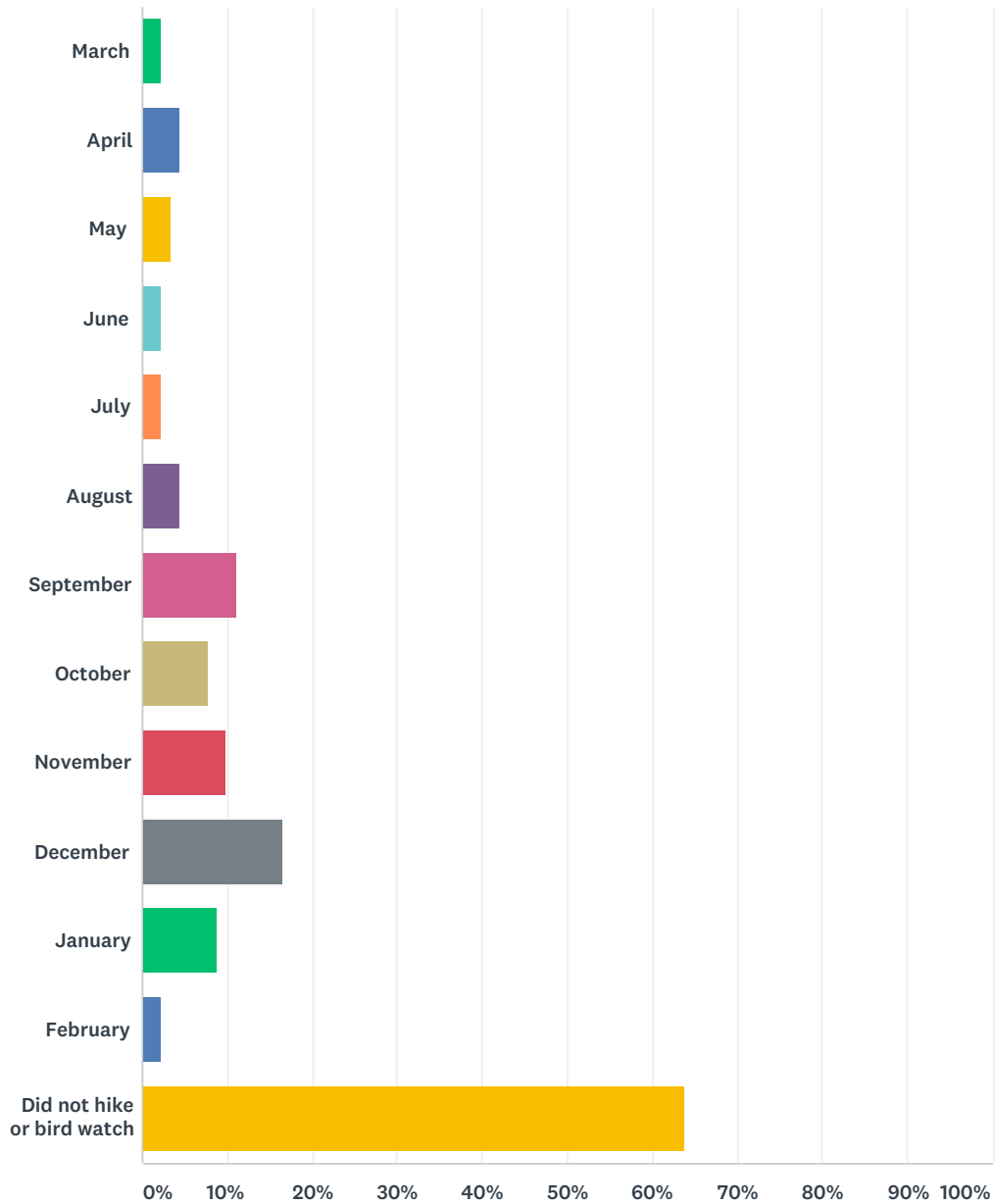

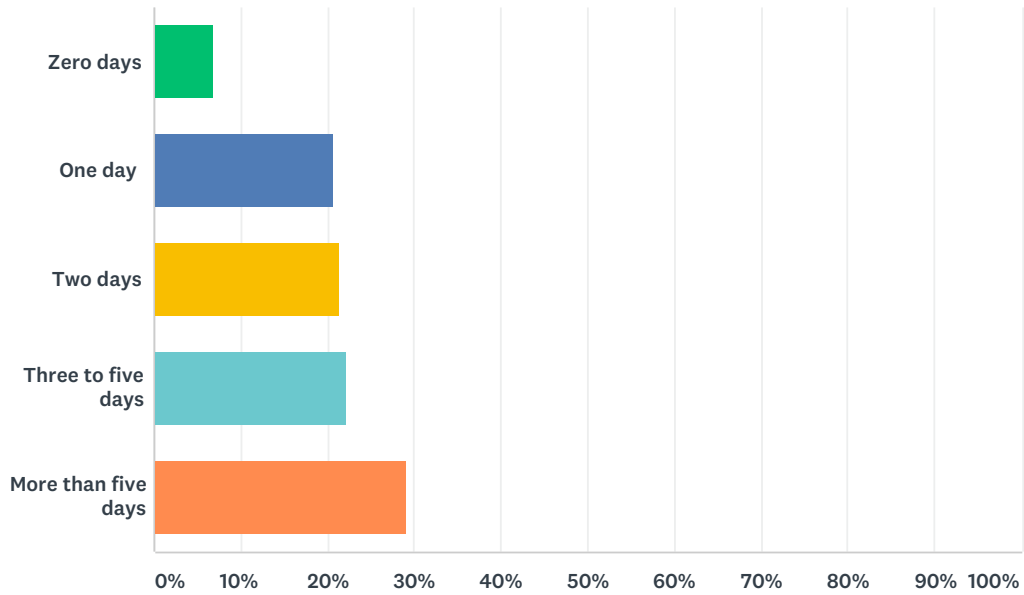

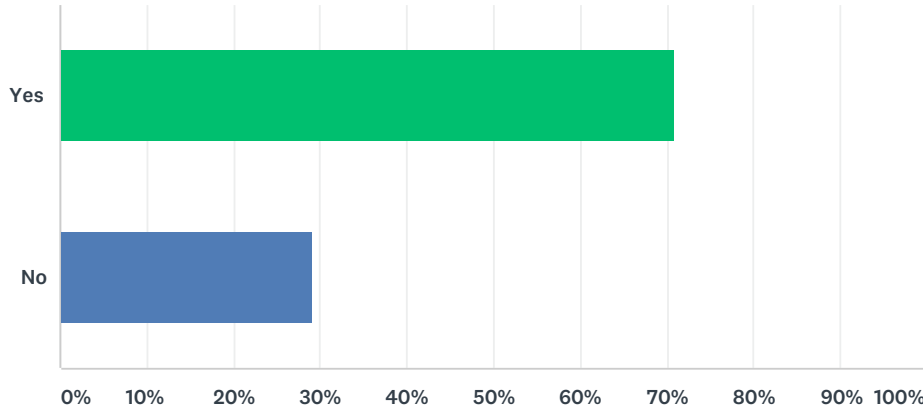

### Q5 Did you also hunt other property during those days or other parts of the hunting season?

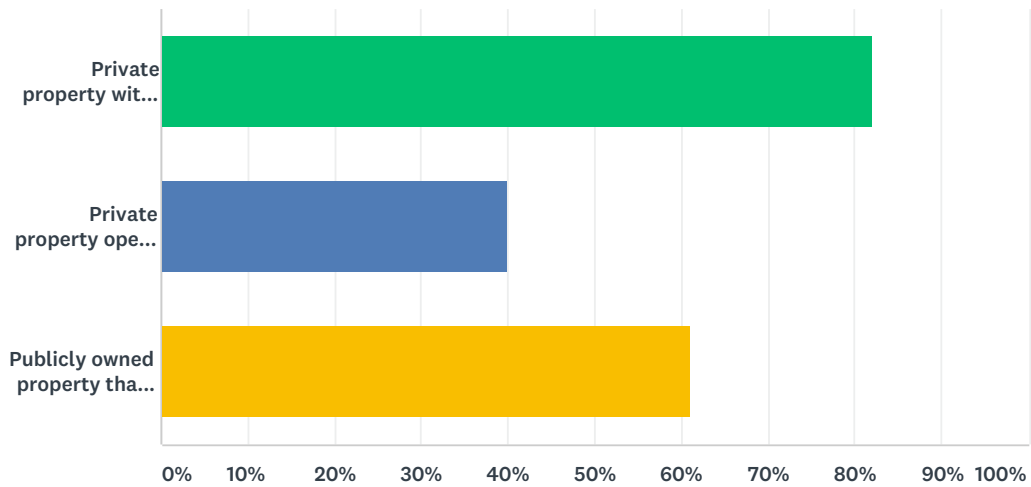

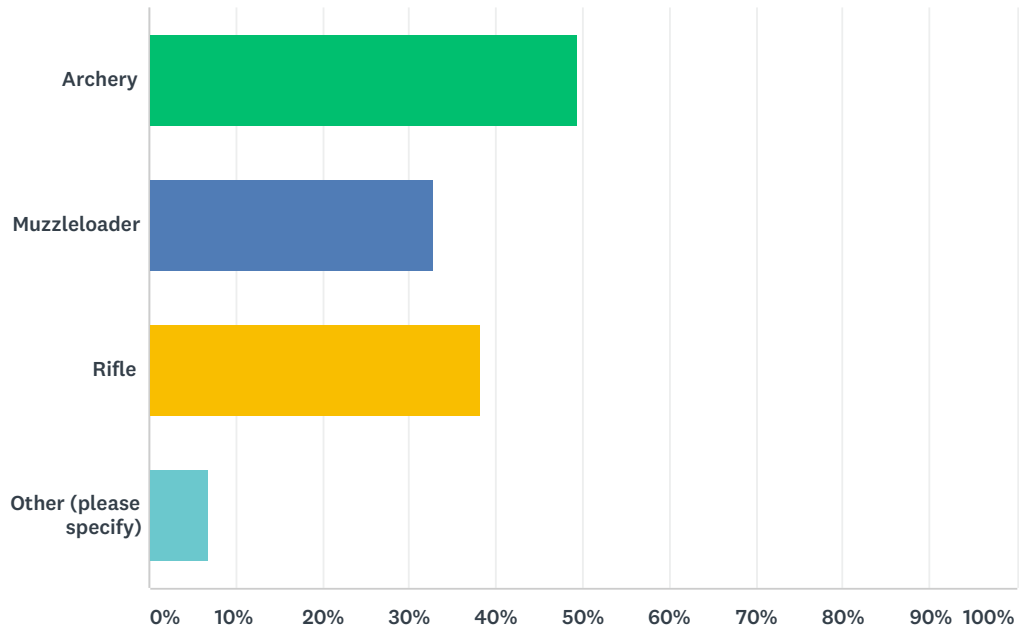

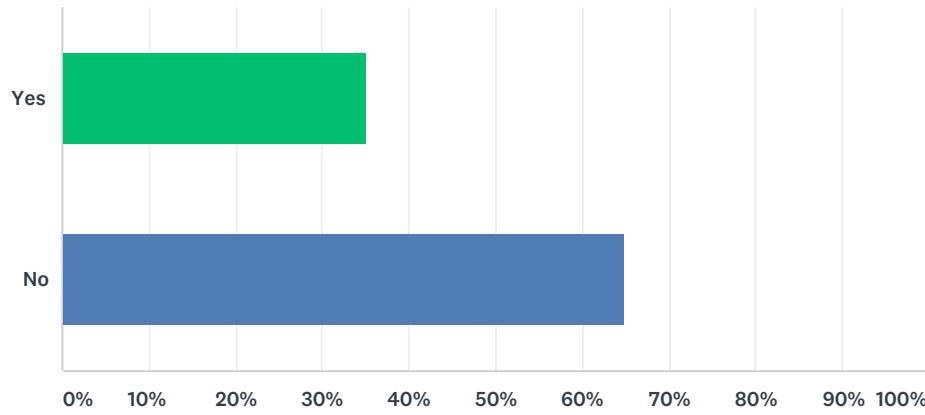

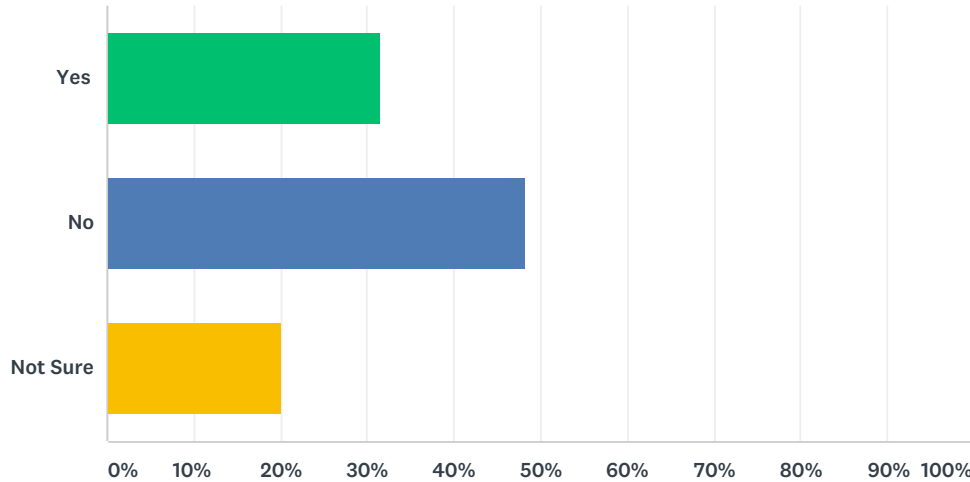

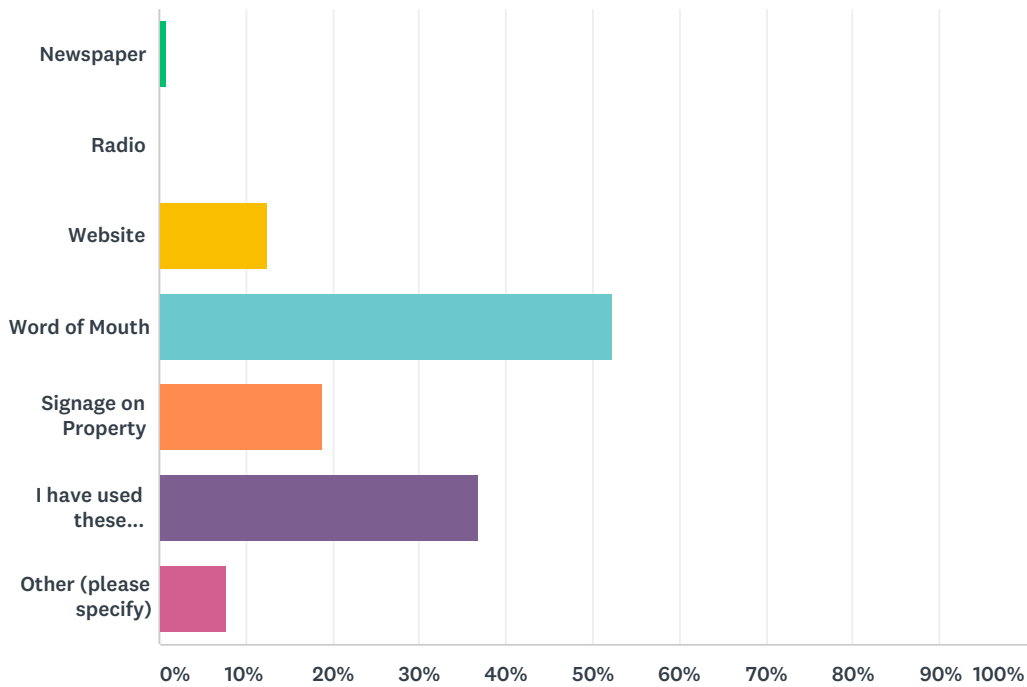

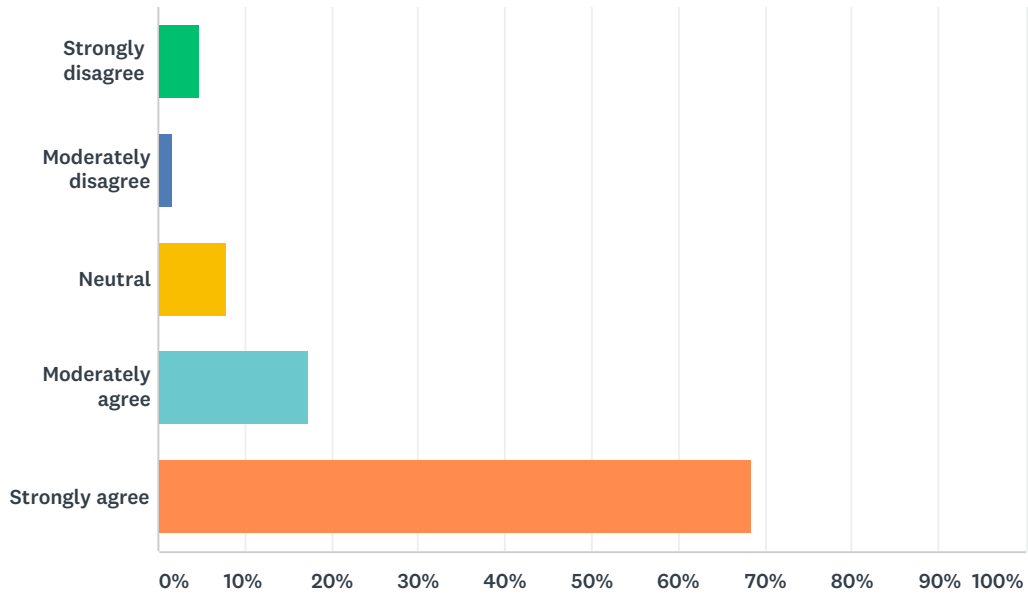

### Q17 Do you agree with the following statement: I would hunt this area again?

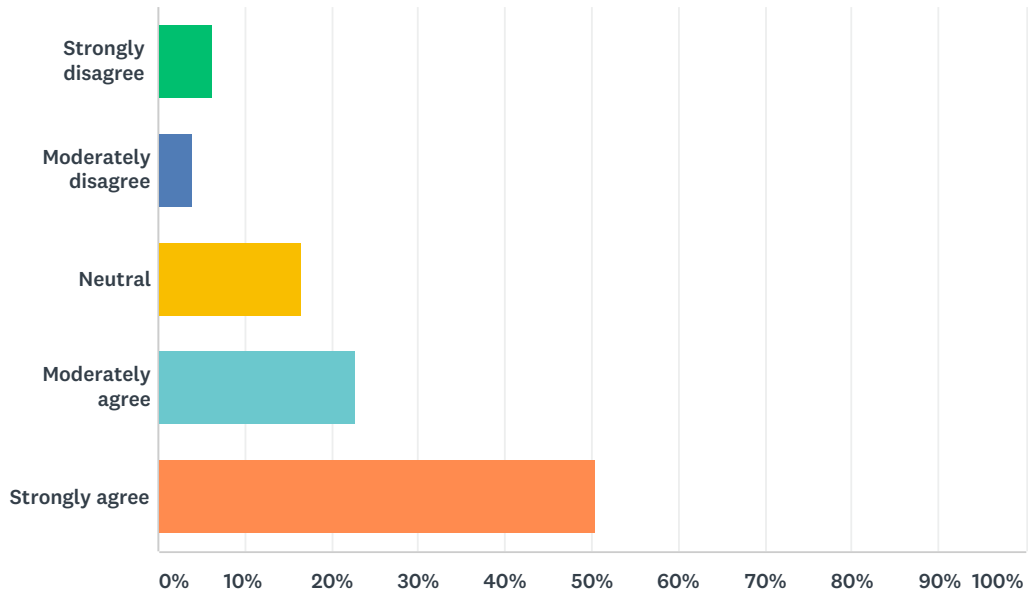

### Q18 Do you agree with the following statement: I would recommend PRRA sites to a friend or relative to hunt?

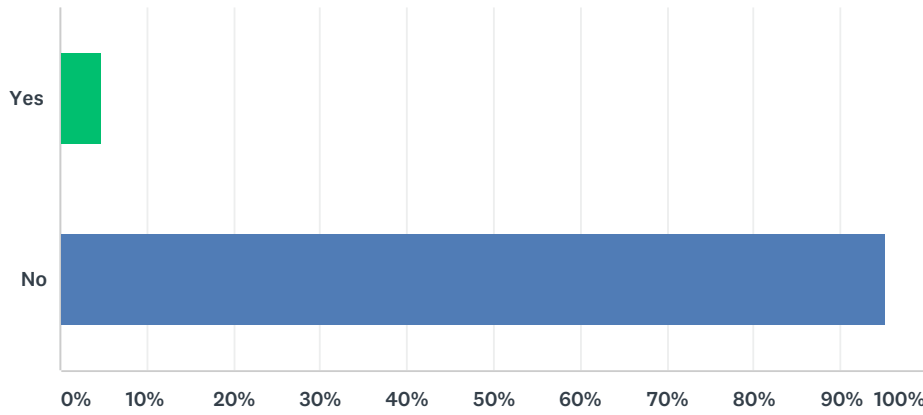

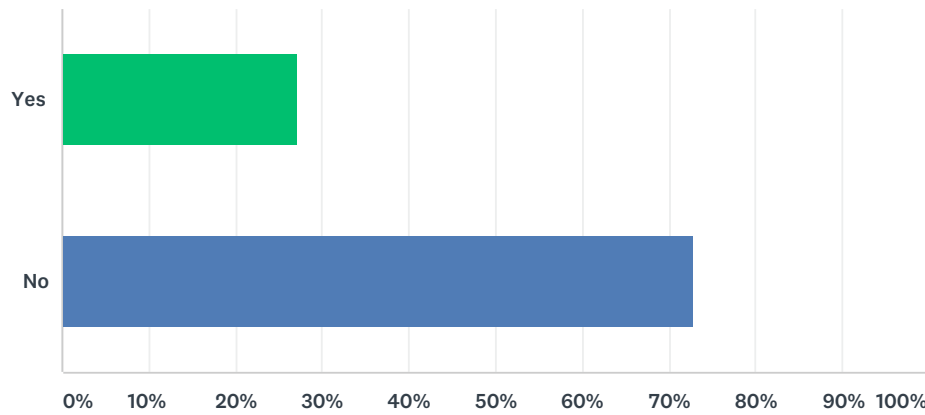

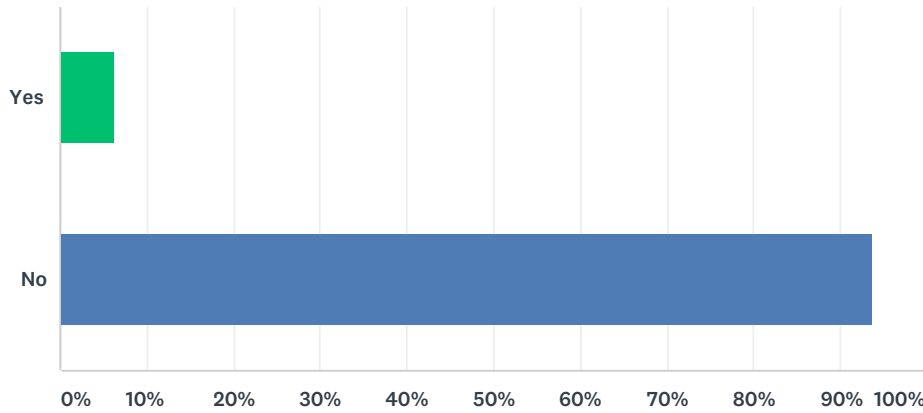
