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Project Objectives:

- Document whooping cranes on the Platte River and along return transects within 3.5 miles of the Platte River.
- Daily flights along the Platte River 45 minutes before sunrise between Chapman NE and Hwy 10 Bridge from March 6, 2021 April 29th, 2021.

Pilot and aircraft must be available daily between March 6 and April 29th, 2021

All flights will be flown at 750 feet above ground level at approximately 100 mph unless conditions (weather, avian species, etc.) dictate otherwise. Daily flights will be initiated at their origin (Chapman or Wood River) 30 minutes prior to sunrise and generally require 2 hours to complete. Flights will proceed along predetermined flight transects with the river transect being flown east to west and return transects west to east.

NOTE: Price requested are <u>hourly rates</u> for aircraft and pilot. Payment will be made on actual hours worked and expenses incurred.
